#### **Certificates & letters**

Straightforward certificate of a fact £20.00

Confirmation of something contained in the medical record

Private sick note/letter not covered by Med3 regulations £30.00

e.g. for periods <7 days, or more detailed letter for employers/universities, or for cancellation of gym membership

Freedom from infection certificate £30.00

eg for school, travel or employment

Fit for the gym £30.00

This is for private gyms/health clubs, and does not include Exercise for Health referrals

Passport countersignatures - your doctor is not permitted to sign these any more

Firearm/shotgun applications £133.00

This applies to medical reports requested by the police for declared conditions — there is no fee if the police simply notify the GP for our records and no report is required

### Travel & transport

Private prescriptions £10.00

for medication either in anticipation of an ailment whilst abroad but not required at the time of issue, or for malaria prophylaxis

Fit to travel certificate with pre-existing condition £35.00

Fitness to fly for pregnant women £25.00

Confirming normal pregnancy and estimated date of confinement at the planned time of travel

Simple letter confirming conditions and medications £25.00

Charity parachute jump forms £30.00
